## Education Visits Dress Code

- Students should adhere to the specific instructions of visit leaders in regard to dress code on that visit.
- If students wear College uniform on the visit, then the same standards of uniform apply on the visit as in College.
- If students are permitted to wear their own clothes, then clothing and footwear should be sensible, modest and suitable for the activity being undertaken.
- Students must not wear football shirts or wear clothing displaying offensive slogans or images.
- Bags should be fit for purpose: large enough to carry what is required, and comfortable to carry. They should not have offensive slogans.
- On residential visits, where possible, students must ensure that items are labelled with their name.
- If expensive items are brought on school visits it is the student's responsibility for ensuring they are safe. The College is not to be held responsible for lost or stolen items.
- KS3 and 4 students should not wear jewellery or make-up.
