## Student Health and Safety Agreement

It is important that each of us is aware of health and safety procedures in order to help keep accidents to a minimum. An awareness of health and safety will not only keep you safe but can also support others attending Emmanuel College.

We should be on the lookout for a potentially unsafe environment or situation, and take action so that together we are working in an environment that is not exposing anyone to unnecessary risk. No one should embark on an activity or put themselves in a situation that is unsafe.

In particular, as a student, you should:

- take all reasonable care for the health and safety of yourself and everyone else who may be affected by your actions or negligence;
- cooperate fully with College staff when any statutory or other health and safety procedure is followed (for example, fire drills); deliberately setting off the fire alarm will result in permanent exclusion;
- behave in an orderly manner at all times;
- comply fully with safety instructions issued by staff with responsibility for safety (for example in PE, technology or science lessons);
- report any defects or dangers to a member of staff immediately;
- do not misuse any item provided by the College;
- do not run in College or outside on the way up to the Granary;
- always cross roads with utmost care at the puffin crossing with central pedestrian refuges.
