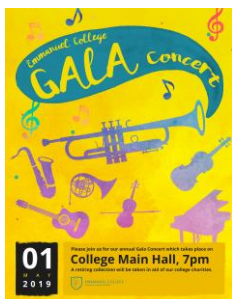

Emmanuel College U18s competed in the prestigious National School Rugby 7s tournament held at Rosslyn Park, London, earlier this week. This is the biggest schools' rugby tournament in the world, and attracts over 250 participating schools. In a tough group, Emmanuel played some outstanding rugby, finishing in third position in their group and narrowly missing out on second spot as they were edged out in the last seconds by the renowned Monmouth School for Boys. This has been Emmanuel's best finish in the tournament to date, and is credit to the hard work the boys have put into training over the last term.
