Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to share with you our plans for reporting and assessment this term.

In Years 7-10, every student will receive an interim report at Easter, with GCSE trajectory grades, based on assessments totalling 90-120 marks undertaken this term.

Year 12 parents will continue to receive six weekly reports based on A Level assessments in all their subjects.

Students in Year 11 and Year 13 should be receiving regular meaningful feedback from their teachers. Given the uncertainty about the grade awarding processes for the summer, we consider it unwise to publish formal attainment data at this stage; therefore, these students will not receive academic reports at the end of this term.
