Dear Parents, Carers and Students

Earlier this year, Year 11 students who were interested in enrolling in the Emmanuel Sixth Form in September informed us about what courses they were interested in taking.

Many of you will have had an opportunity to review and reflect on this, particularly if you have started to look at the transition resources for your subjects.

We would like all students to confirm with us what subjects they would like to study in Sixth Form by completing [this form](#) by Wednesday 7 July. You can see how the timetable is structured and which subjects can be taken in combination [here](#), but if you have any questions about how to complete the form, please email sixthform@emmanuelctc.org.uk. Please note, there have been some changes to how the subjects are blocked since the provisional structure was published, so students should check this carefully. We will no longer be offering Graphic Communication as a course this September. I recognise this may come as a disappointment to a small number of students and would encourage them to consider Art, Design and Technology: Product Design and IT as possible alternatives.

We will be completing Sixth Form enrolment on the afternoon of GCSE results day, **Thursday 12 August** and it is important, therefore, that we have an up-to-date picture of the courses on which you wish to enrol.

By completing the form you are not committing yourself to join Emmanuel Sixth Form, nor are you guaranteed a place, **however, only students who complete this form will be enrolled on courses on Thursday 12 August.**

I would also like to take the opportunity to remind you about the transition resources which are on our website [here](#). Beneath the subject course videos, students will find a transition task for each of their subjects. These cover the core skills and knowledge that students should be proficient in for each subject. Each of these should take between 3-5 hours for each subject. In addition to this, there are extension tasks for each subject, should students identify that they need to complete, or wish to complete, extra preparatory work in readiness for September. Between now and September I would ask that students download the September Preparation Task for each of the subjects they are planning to take. Students should schedule in time to complete all the questions and tasks contained within, and then bring this work to their first lesson where it will be reviewed by their teachers.
