Dear Parents

I am aware that some of you and of course, your children, have been frustrated by the events of last week surrounding the planned covid vaccinations. It appears that despite the best efforts of the school immunisation team, some students were not able to be given the vaccine because they ran out of time.

We have been trying to seek clarity from the school immunisation team about next steps and I am sorry to say that I am unable to provide any clear information about this matter other than to pass on the most recent message we have received from the team.

The school immunisation service write: "We aren't aware of any further opportunities at present for children aged 12-15 year olds to receive the covid vaccination, the best advice we can give to parents is to await possible announcements from the government.

Due to the amount of preparation and tight timescales we've been set, we are unable to process any additional covid consent forms in time for the school's session. Unfortunately, some immunisation sessions aren't being completed due to time constraints.

We are doing our utmost to achieve the deadlines we've been set by the government and can't express enough how grateful we are for your support and assistance in the preparation and running of the sessions and for all of your patience."

We shall keep you informed of any further information that is passed to us.
