Dear Parents and Carers

Online transition plans are now well underway in preparation for your child joining Emmanuel College in September. We do hope that you and your child have been enjoying the interactive content each week and learning more about life at Emmanuel College.

To support the online content, you will already be aware we are hosting two transition days in-person, at Emmanuel College, taking place on **Wednesday 6 July and Thursday 7 July 2022**. We do hope your child is looking forward to this event. You will be able to see the activities they are involved in by following our Twitter account **@Emmanuelctc** and **#2022intake**.

To ensure things go smoothly, we would like to clarify a few details for parents and carers regarding the logistics of the days. For the two days, students need to wear comfortable clothing such as jogging bottoms or leggings, with trainers, as there will be opportunities to take part in sporting activities during some of the lessons. In addition, all students must ensure they have the following equipment with them:

- A backpack to store equipment in
- A pencil case including colouring pencils, writing pen, drawing pencil, ruler and rubber
- Reusable bottle filled with water
- Packed lunch.

If you will be driving to Emmanuel College, please park your car in the Watergate Forest Car Park (NE11 9RQ) and walk with your child round to the main pedestrian entrance on Consett Road where you will then be greeted by staff and Sixth Form students. At the end of each transition day, students must be collected by parents or carers. Students will not be allowed to leave College without an adult. Student collection at the end of the day will take place from the pedestrian entrance on Whickham Highway, down from Watergate Forest Car Park.

A parental meeting will take place in College on Thursday evening to provide you with additional information regarding uniform, College policies and other frequently asked questions ready for your child joining us in September. The College Senior Management Team will be in attendance along with tutors and members of the wider leadership team. **Students should not attend this event.** Please ensure that you arrive at College prior to **6:00pm** for a prompt start. There will also be an opportunity to speak to staff at the end of the evening.
