### **Year 10 Examinations**

I am writing to give you advance notice that the annual Year 10 examinations will take place from **Thursday 20 April to Friday 28 April** inclusive. Full attendance during the exams is expected and we ask you not to book any medical or other routine appointments during this period.

These examinations will give a true picture of the level at which students are at present, with a little over a year until GCSE exams begin. It is important, therefore, for our Year 10 students to work hard to achieve maximum success in these examinations and show their true ability in their chosen subjects.

I strongly recommend that revision for these exams should begin now, if it hasn't already. In preparation for the examinations, I have recommended that all students should use their time in school well, which includes maximising their time for independent studies both before and after school.

On the basis of these examinations, and on the work done during the course of this academic year, results will be issued on 19 May.
