## TIPS FOR SUCCESS

### Listening and Reading Exams

- Ensure you have revised the vocabulary thoroughly.
- Never leave an answer blank.
- Take care with spelling in the last question on the listening paper (phonics).
- On the last question on the reading paper (translations), ensure that you do not miss out any words.

### Writing exam

- Write in as much detail as possible.
- Provide opinions.
- Answer every bullet point on the question you have chosen.
- Revise the present tense before the exam.
- As you write, check all verb endings to make sure they are correct.
- Avoid accidentally writing in another language (German, Spanish or using words in English).
- Do your best and look upon the exam as an opportunity to show off everything you have learned.
