Year 10 have an opportunity to visit Newcastle University to find out more about higher education, funding options, as well as more about what life it is like at university.

The year group will be divided in two, with half of the year group going on Thursday 13 June – 10 Cockell, 10 Lawrence, 10 Crane, 10 Douglas) and the remainder going on Wednesday 19 June – 10 Farrelly, 10 Cumming, 10 Lown, 10 Charlton). The object of the day is very much to inspire students to think further about higher education, with much of the information being of value to any student considering this path of higher education. Students will need to make their own way to the university for 9:45am, where they will be met by Emmanuel College staff at the Hadrian Building location 4 on the map [here](#). This is close to the Haymarket Metro station. Parents dropping students off can access the car park next to the Hadrian building from the south, or if coming from the north are best to drop off at the car park by the Great North Museum: Hancock.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch as there is no catering provided and students will not have opportunity to buy any food or drink during the day. The day will end at approximately 2:30pm and students will be allowed to go home at this time.
