We will also have performances from the College Orchestra, Jazz Band, String Quartet, and our Performance Choir, as well as students delivering passages from the bible that depict the story of the birth of Jesus Christ.

It is important to remind parents that as part of sending your child to Emmanuel College, you agree that they will attend two compulsory after school events per academic year, which are the Carol Service and Presentation Evening.
