



## Year 9 Music Examination



### Listening and Appraising Exam

Students will be assessed on their ability to understand the key terminology from the current unit *Latin American Music* as well as *Band Music* and *Pop Music* studied earlier in the year. Students will listen to extracts of music heard from their music lessons to identify the key musical features used as well as key vocabulary they have learned. This is a written assessment and there will be no practical exam.

This exam will also be combined with the performance and compositions assessments that students completed earlier in the year to give an overall grade.
