It is often at this time of year, and over the summer holidays, that families take stock and if necessary, replenish uniform items.

Our 2026 uniform code and guide for Years 7-11 has been updated. Please [click here](#) to view the code and guide. It is also available on the College policies page on our website.

Please can I ask that you read this and if necessary, ensure that appropriate replacement uniform items are purchased by the start of the new term?

In particular, please note:

1. Requirements on skirt length; the uniform code makes clear that: *[skirts] must touch the top of the knee and not be rolled*. Whilst I understand that students grow during the year, it is our expectation that by the start of the new term in September, this requirement on skirt length is adhered to.
2. That 'trainer type' shoes are not permitted. A few students have purchased such shoes. The uniform code provides a list of shoes that are and are not acceptable, which should help future purchase. Any student wearing any type of incorrect shoe in September, including 'trainer type' shoes, will be asked to replace them.

We, of course, do not want any family to purchase an item that does not fit according to the policy or is the incorrect item. All students will have their uniform checked in the first week of the Autumn term and families will be asked to purchase replacement items if need be. The uniform code makes clear which items have to be purchased via EAS and which items can be purchased from other retailers. If you are purchasing an item from EAS, the last selling date for a guaranteed delivery before the new academic year is **Friday 31 July**.
